

Thorn Park Picnic Shelter is available to rent for Brownstown Residents only beginning the first week of April. Rentals are taken in person Monday-Friday 8 a.m.-5:30 p.m. at the Community Center. Call 734-675-0920 for more information.

\$200 fee/\$200 refundable deposit

Rental Guidelines:

Rentals are available in 6 hour time blocks between the hours of 10A-4P on Saturday and Sunday and 12-8P Monday-Friday. During this time the renter will have exclusive use of the Picnic Shelter, tables within it and the East grill.

Parties of any kind are not permitted in the shelter without a rental agreement and payment in advance.

If the Shelter is not rented it will be available for drop in public use only.

Drop in parties are not permitted. The use of balloons, piñatas, banners and other party decorations will not be allowed unless the shelter is rented

Shelter rental does not include splash pad admission.

Renters may purchase up to 50 splash pad wrist bands in advance prior to the day of party. Refunds will not be given for unused wrist bands. Splash pad use is not exclusive.

Renters are required to clean up all party supplies at the end of party, excessive trash must be taken to the dumpster in the East parking lot. Failure to comply will result in loss of deposit.

Thorn Park and Shelter Area Rules:

- * Alcohol/Vaping/Smoking or Tobacco use of any kind is not permitted.
- * Shoes must be worn when outside of the splash pad.
- * Tables, chairs, inflatables, tents or shade structures are not permitted to be brought into the park.
- * Vehicles may not enter the park area. Parking or driving on grass not permitted. Parking is permitted in parking lot only.
- * Bikes, skate boards, roller skates and other riding toys not permitted.
- * Dogs or other pets are not permitted.
- * Moving of picnic tables is not permitted.
- * Confetti and glitter are not permitted.
- * Outside cooking devices are not permitted. There is a charcoal grill onsite for use.
- * Firearms or other weapons are not permitted.
- * Fireworks and other explosives, sparklers, smoke devices are not permitted.
- * All trash must be placed in trash receptacles. Excessive trash must be taken to the dumpster in the East parking lot.
- * Music must be family friendly, free from vulgarity and kept at a volume so as not to disturb others. Recreation staff will have discretion on what is deemed inappropriate or too loud.



On site recreation staff shall enforce shelter and park rules. Those not adhering to rules will be asked to leave.
